To save getting lost and losing your car, print and bring this to the Fieldays on 15 to 18 June 2016. It is the Southern Hemisphere's largest agricultural event, attracting 120,000 people over four days, from all around the world. New Zealand is a leader in low-cost farming, with the latest in agricultural equipment, products, advice and services, many of which are on display. Farmers and buyers can meet 1,400 businesses on 50 hectares (124 acres) of exhibits, which are hard to see all of, even over the four days. The New Zealand Agricultural Fieldays sites & parking cover such a large area that visitors can get lost, or not find their car or the bus stop. Print this photo and make a note on it in which of the ten car parks shown above you've parked, and the location of the bus stop, and the time that the last bus leaves.

Save yourself what can be a long walk from where you park, to the exhibition area, by parking in the Knox Street car park in Hamilton and catching a free bus from there. Parking there is free for Fieldays bus users. Take your parking ticket with you to Fieldays and redeem it at the Gate 1 Bus Office in return for a FREE Knox St carpark voucher. There is a bus every half hour from 8am.

Caravan and camper van overnight parks are available on the south side of Mystery Creek Road, opposite the Gate 2 main entrance to Fieldays. The Hamilton airport is shown in the photo on the left.
